 - 2nd sub-project: Derivation of adaptation possibilities and multipliers

Content and goal of the Workshop

Content

The results of a survey commissioned by the FOEN, in which Swiss universities participated, are presented in a short summary. The aim of the survey was to find examples of how to integrate sustainability in teaching and to draw conclusions in order to find optimal framework conditions.

Goal

How can sustainability be effectively integrated into university teaching?

In small groups, the participants will further develop and concretise new or already identified implementation approaches for the integration of sustainability into university teaching based on framework conditions from the survey.



Workshop: Wishes/ideas from survey and evaluation by SUD 2023 participants

- Develop a competency framework for sustainability in teaching at Swiss universities
- Establish overarching elective/compulsory modules with ECTS credit (major/minor, etc.) in all departments/faculties of the university
- Uniform and central exchange
- Platform for teaching material and practical examples from Swiss universities
- ... or an idea of your own?



Workshop with 6-3-5 Method

- Choose one of the ideas from the survey and from the evaluation done by SUD 2023 participants.
- Question: Which three implementation steps do you think are necessary to start the project?
- Each person takes a sheet of paper and is the project leader for this idea.
- Each person now writes down three implementation steps that are necessary for this project to be implemented.
- Then rotate until each person has made additions on each sheet.

Conclusion: Project leader presents a summary of the steps



Summary of the workshop results

- Project ideas were not questioned, and the project ideas were perceived as relevant
- Numerous ideas have emerged on how these could be implemented with an 'Action Plan'
- Out of these ideas, these four points can be summarised as relevant:
 - Common understanding of sustainability
 - Identification of sustainability-specific problems as a starting point for a competence profile and as a subject in teaching (case studies, service learning)
 - Involvement of management, department management and students
 - Define project manager/committee
 - Define stakeholders or external organisation that will be responsible for monitoring and promotes integration (financial, personal resources)
